



## Migrating From Millennium™ Software (TSN) to ALL-Ways™ Software (BRIS)

### How to proceed

While Millennium Software and ALL-Ways Software are virtually identical, the overall Millennium Class Ratings and Race Ratings are on a different scale than those used by ALL-Ways. Therefore, it is necessary to start with a “fresh” installation of ALL-Ways Software and to re-build Race Databases using ALL-Ways Data Files.

### Re-building Race Databases

The Batch Download Files, which are available from the ALL-Ways Data File Page on the BRIS Web site, are an excellent way to automatically build instant, large and current ALL-Ways Race Databases.

### Non Database File Transfers

There are some files in the Millfile folder that may, if you choose to do so, be copy/pasted into the new Franfile folder that is created when installing ALL-Ways Software. Here are the files:

<b>File Name</b>	<b>File Purpose</b>
CUSTREP	Holds Custom Handicapping Report definitions
factorpref	Holds preferences for the factors to print on Impact Value and other reports
gap_search_def.xxx	Holds Custom Search Definitions for each track (xxx = track code)
IV.xxx IVDEX.xxx	These two files hold Handicapping Profiles for each track. Keep the files together!
prefer	Holds Preferences set in the Custom Module
rankdef	Holds definitions for the Top 10/Ranking Report
template	Holds the Handicapping Session Template
WagerTickets	Holds the database of Wager Tickets, if any, created in the Wager Module
