

## ALL-Ways™ Handicapping Profiles for Monmouth (Highly Segmented Races)

These ALL-Ways Handicapping Profiles were created by a long term ALL-Ways handicapper. This person has had good success using the feature in ALL-Ways™ Software that allows you to segment the specific types of races targeted by the Handicapping Profile.

Here are examples of this ALL-Ways handicapper's profile naming conventions:

Example: "Honest Pace 8 ord"

This is an Honest Pace dirt sprint with an ALL-Ways Race Rating of 108-115 and an Orderly race category.

ALL-Ways Race Ratings (The higher the rating, the higher class horses are running):

An "8" indicates an ALL-Ways Race Rating in the range of 108 to 115

A "7" indicates an ALL-Ways Race Rating under 108

A "16" indicates an ALL-Ways Race Rating over 115

ALL-Ways Race Category abbreviations used are:

"ord" indicates an Orderly race (one or two standout horses)

"cnt" or "ct" indicates a Contentious race (no standouts)

"caos" or "chaos" indicates a Chaos race (no horse has run to today's Par Speed)

Special Place and Show Handicapping Profiles:

A "p" in the profile name indicates a Place Handicapping Profile

An "s" or "sh" in the profile name indicates a Show Handicapping Profile

Another example: "Lone Early Pace 1 1/16 ord 8"

This is a Lone Early Pace dirt route at a distance of 1 1/16 mile with a race rating of 108-115, An Orderly race

Add'l distance abbreviations are "70" for 1 mile plus 70 yards, "1/8" for 1 1/8 mile.

Other Abbreviations:

A "12" or "12+" indicates Handicapping Profiles for long shots over \$12 to win.

"n2" indicates races for 2 year olds were excluded

"bc" indicates specifically for the Breeders Cup

"stk/a" indicates Stakes and Allowance races

"njb" indicates specifically for New Jersey State Bred races
